The annually organized fair brings together top authors and publishers from around the world. It is a valuable opportunity to promote a culture of reading from an early age through innovative programming.

- Instill the importance of book fairs in children from an early age.
- Support the formation of knowledge awareness and promote children's literature as a sector.
- Provide a reliable and diverse source of children's books across various languages and genres.

About the 5th Edition of the Children's Book Fair

Overview:

The 5th edition will take place at Ithra from 14–19 July 2025. The program includes:

- 19 interactive events and sessions designed for children, including:
 - o Interactive storytelling sessions tailored to various age groups
 - o Educational discussions with a selection of experts in children's literature
 - Panel sessions on innovation and cultural identity
 - Book signings with prominent Arabic-language children's authors
 - Meet-the-author sessions with leading children's literature writers
 - Activities that promote bilingual reading and cultural diversity

- 20 local and international publishing houses specializing in children's literature
- Participants from European, Arab, and Asian countries
- Participation from notable institutions including: King Abdulaziz Public Library, King Salman Global Academy for Arabic Language, Abu Dhabi Children's Library and House of Wisdom in Sharjah
- Parallel educational programming for ages 16+
