

In solidarity with the Kingdom's leadership and public efforts to combat the spread of the coronavirus, we shut our doors and took the steps to continue our purpose, promise and mission to deliver enriching experiences and connect with our audiences and the homebound public while ensuring the safety of our audiences and our teams. Ithra Connect, our flagship online initiative, provided a platform to stay connected with our communities, giving them access to Ithra

notwithstanding the distance. Taking our 2020 offerings fully online, it grew to feature more than 50 ongoing programs for children, families, students and creatives covering different interests and formats, encapsulating podcasts, talk shows, quizzes, video series, a collective online diary, virtual exhibitions and tours, seminars, society meetups and much more.

Through continued virtual communication and innovative use of our digital platforms, Ithra fulfilled its promise to inspire creativity within the Kingdom and elevate Saudi content to global heights. We continued to provide resources, experiences and an inspiration. Ithra is the beating heart of the Kingdom's cultural and creative ecosystem — it is where imagination is powered, ideas are born, knowledge shared and culture celebrated. We collaborate with local and international entities and partners to develop creative potential and encourage cultural conversations in the Kingdom.

As we embark on a new year with Ithra's doors open and welcoming the public once again, safely and socially distanced, we look forward to new beginnings and continuing our mission to enrich and inspire.



Located in Dhahran, Saudi Arabia, Ithra features a five gallery museum, an exhibition hall, a performing arts theater, an innovation lab, a cinema, a state-of-the-art library and the first children's museum in the nation.

Ithra — from the Arabic word for "enrichment" — is a platform for art, creativity and culture. It is dedicated to education and innovation. It is Ithra's mission to cultivate the creative economy; and it does so by supporting the work of individuals in visual, cinematic, media and performing arts — as well as design and entrepreneurship.

The Ithra building is an architectural masterpiece resulting from an international competition won by the Norwegian firm Snohetta. It features a unique skin made of 360km of individually bent steel pipes designed to handle the stresses of its coastal desert site, most notably heat from the sun and wind-born sand. With the steel-pipe exterior set alongside the rammed earth walls of Ithra's interior plaza, the building combines the world's newest and oldest architectural technologies to create a model of sustainability that was awarded Gold LEED status — Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design, the leading green certification — for its built environment. In 2018, Ithra was listed by Time magazine as one of "the 100 greatest places in the world to visit."

At Ithra, we envision a future in which Saudi Arabia is a beacon for knowledge and creativity. We aim to make a tangible and positive impact on human development by inspiring a passion for knowledge, creativity and cross-cultural engagement for the future of the Kingdom.

## Museum

The Ithra Museum is home to five galleries, dedicated to provide a journey of discovery through time. The museum combines interactive exhibits, educated lectures and tours. Funoon Gallery focuses on international and Saudi contemporary art, the Ajyaal Gallery provides a voyage into Saudi's heritage, Kunooz Gallery discovers the beauty of Islamic design and history, the Rehlaat Gallery explores the diverse natural ecosystem and history of the Arabian Peninsula, and Aramcorama, which features highlights of Aramco history from the Archives.

Ithra's Idea Lab is a three-level innovation facility where aspiring creators, inventors and entrepreneurs can develop their ideas and transform them into prototypes and marketable products. It features a materials library, design exhibitions, -3D printers, meeting spaces and an amphitheater for presenting projects.













## **Theater**

The -900seat Ithra Theater is a world-class opera-style stage venue that hosts a diverse program of Saudi and international productions, performances, ceremonies, conferences and talks.



## Cinema

Ithra's -300seat Cinema offers a screening venue catering to the interests of Ithra's diverse audience with events to engage and inspire while functioning as a production platform, supporting the Kingdom's burgeoning film industry talent.


















## **Great Hall**








## **Ithra Tower**


## **Energy Exhibit**

Ithra's ever-popular Energy Exhibit explores a world of discoveries in energy science through interactive displays, advanced technologies and multimedia. Established in its original form as a traveling exhibit in the 1950s by Saudi Aramco, the Energy Exhibit finally found a permanent home in its current location in the late 1980s, when it was the only museum in the Eastern Province. It has evolved into a state-of-the-art facility that offers an exciting and engaging educational journey designed to explore how natural resources and alternative forms of energy are harnessed safely and efficiently.



The Ithra Library is Saudi Arabia's first digitally integrated library. It is one of the largest public libraries in the region, with a collection of over 270,000 paper volumes in Arabic and English arranged across four floors. The Library also offers over 1 million audio and e-books, with more resources to come. The Library hosts book signings and special talks by prominent national and international guests, story times for children, literary competitions and oral history sessions. The Ithra Library also runs the annual iRead national reading competition, a flagship Ithra program that has drawn more than 70,000 participants from all educational levels since 2014.

## Children's Museum

Ithra's Children's Museum, the first of its kind in the Kingdom, is an immersive creative space that offers visitors up to age 12 exciting and interactive play-based experiences. The Children's Museum features a creativity-inspiring Story Cave, an introduction to the beauty and rich history of Islamic art through calligraphy, geometric patterns, painting and abstract imagery, an environmental Eco Lab where budding scientists can explore marine, physical and environmental science, the Our World themed area and a space in the mezzanine where children up to age five can play, learn and discover across five themed zones.













#### January

#### Ithra Incubator

Two Ithra Incubator programs began their operations in Qassim and Ha'il. In all, the initiative trained 438 teachers (male and female) and 684 students (male and female) underwent 22,440 learning hours in STEAM (science, technology, engineering, art and math) content. A similar program in the Northern Border region reached 35 schools and mainly focused on math and robotics.

## Ithra Content Commission Initiative

Ithra selected 14 projects for the inaugural edition of its National Program for Supporting Cultural and Creative Content – the Ithra Content Commissioning Initiative. The program aimed to support the production of local content and provide Saudi creatives with new opportunities within the Kingdom's creative and cultural sector.

#### **February**

#### Ithra Cultural Days: Vietnam

Ithra held its inaugural Cultural Days program, which involved two weeks of activities showcasing Vietnamese culture. The highlight was the Vietnamese circus show AO, which played to sell-out crowds. Ithra hosted music, performances, food and crafts, attracting 45,000 visitors.

#### March

#### Ithra launches Ithra Connect

The physical doors closed at Ithra because of the pandemic. However, new virtual doors opened. Ithra responded to the global lockdown by developing an unprecedented amount of new and relevant content to serve our audiences online. Content and engagement became an emergency service of sorts, assisting the public in dealing with the stress and isolation of lockdown. Ithra Connect ultimately reached more than 1 million virtual attendees.

#### April

### Your Heroes, the Nation's Heroes Campaign

As a tribute to the heroes from the various sectors and fields who have worked tirelessly for the health and safety of the public, Ithra launched the "Your Heroes, the Nation's Heroes" المالكم أبطال الوطن# campaign on Ithra's Twitter account. The campaign invited the public to participate in recognizing their heroes. whose names would be projected onto Ithra's Tower. The campaign was a success with more than 10,000 submissions received.

#### May

#### **Eid Parade**

Ithra launched a hybrid Eid celebration, featuring a parade of decorated wagons traveling through cities in the Eastern Province. The event was a much-needed boost after weeks of lockdown and reached 100,000 people.

#### June

#### Ithra Talks

As part of the Ithra Connect program, Ithra broadcasted live online events with international and regional figures. Acclaimed English actor Idris Elba, the American astrophysicist Neil deGrasse Tyson, the international architect Kjetil Traedal Thorsen and Ithra's Head of Advisory, Fatmah Al-Rashid, were among the guests.

#### ResiliArt

Ithra also partnered with UNESCO to produce the ResiliArt virtual panel discussion with five leading art and culture professionals. The focus of the debate: "Dystopia to Utopia: Our Changing Cultural Landscape," examined the cultural landscape and potential paths forward in social, political and economic terms from the perspective of the Arab orld.







#### July

#### **50 Thousand Photographs**

The Saudi short film "50 Thousand Photographs" produced by Ithra in 2019, was released in cinemas around Saudi Arabia in 2020.

#### August

#### Eid al-Adha

Ithra offered a series of events for the Eid al-Adha celebrations, including "Explore Eid," which offered visitors the opportunity to participate in a two-hour group competition called the Seven-Mile Journey. Ithra welcomed more than 19,000 visitors.

#### September

#### Saudi National Day

Ithra's hybrid National Day festivities featured exhibitions, music and events to mark the occasion. Highlights included a performance by Al Farabi Band accompanied by Abeer Balubaid on piano and singer Ameen Farsi, live poetry by Saudi poet Abdulatif bin Yousef with music. One exhibition examined the famously decorated doors of Najd, and the other, Kingdom of Cultures, showcased the Kingdom's spectacular and varied landscapes.

#### Saudi Film Festival

The sixth Saudi Film Festival ran from September 2020,6—1, and was showcased online. The program included Saudi film competitions, discussions, workshops and seminars.

#### October

#### Tanween

Ithra staged a hybrid form of the annual Tanween Creativity Season, bringing speakers and experts from around the world to Saudi and regional audiences. In addition, Ithra ran a series of Tanween Challenge projects allowing participants to apply their innovation and creative skillset to live projects.

#### **Y20**

Ithra co-hosted the Y20 summit. The conference brought together young people from across the world to discuss global issues and priorities. The Y20 is the youth-focused element of the G20 summit of world leaders, which was held in Riyadh.

#### **November**

### Memorandum signed with Egyptian Council of Antiquities

Ithra entered into a two-year partnership with the Supreme Council of Egyptian Antiquities to bring 84 timeless masterpieces of Islamic culture from the Museum of Islamic Art in Cairo for exhibition in Dhahran. This was a substantial move in developing future collaboration among museums across the Middle East and Africa. it represented a major stage in the cooperation between Egypt and Saudi Arabia.

#### December

#### Volunteer Day

Ithra marked International Volunteerism Day with a special event to recognize the contribution of volunteers for their work at the King Abdulaziz Center for World Culture.

#### **Arabic Language Day**

Ithra celebrated International Arabic Language Day through a series of activities and programs aimed at promoting the Arabic language and its cultural and intellectual development. The Center also published The Mu'allaqāt for Millennials – a book that addresses and elaborates on the 10 odes (Mu'allaq āt), which interpret poetry and literary history.



# Ithra and the Pandemic



Flexible and forward-looking, Ithra was ready when the pandemic hit. Although Ithra is housed in an architectural masterpiece and features comprehensive cultural facilities, Ithra is much more than a building. Our teams produce cultural content - exhibitions, films, classes, workshops, performances, articles and art. With our doors shuttered and our audiences under lockdown. we led the way with Ithra Connect, a UNESCO-recognized online initiative featuring more than 50 ongoing programs: video series, podcasts, workshops, classes, online exhibitions, a collective COVID19- diary, virtual tours, videos about objects in the collections, camps for kids, DIY videos, international panel discussions, online art group meetups, guiz shows and puzzles. While the Center was closed. Ithra Connect videos alone were viewed more than 20 million times.

The impact of Ithra Connect has been recognized at the regional level at the Middle East Public Relations Association Awards, the region's leading body for public relations and communication professionals. Ithra won the silver award for the Ithra Connect campaign in the Best Arts and Culture category. The campaign win was for Ithra's creative communications in expanding its reach during the global pandemic, using art, innovation and design to engage with domestic, regional and international communities.

UNESCO recognition: Ithra's virtual initiatives – including Ithra Connect, the Ithra Virtual Tour and the Ithra online library – were recognized by UNESCO for helping communities while they stayed at home and fought COVID19-.













#### ResiliArt



The panel was chaired by Dubai-based curator Laura Egerton, and the panelists included Dr. Nada Shabout, professor of Art History and the coordinator of the Contemporary Arab and Muslim Cultural Studies Initiative at the University of North Texas; filmmaker, photographer, archival artist and curator Akram Zaatari; Saudi artist and producer Dr. Ahmed Mater: Islamic art specialist. Linda Komaroff of the Los Angeles County Museum of Art: and Sheikha Hala Mohammed Al Khalifa, the director of the Culture and Arts Directorate at the Bahrain Authority for Culture and Antiquities. The live virtual event was attended by 1,400 participants and the media coverage reached more than 700,000 viewers within the Middle East. The event captured more than 400 original tweets and 19 million impressions.

Ithra partnered with UNESCO to host the first ResiliArt debate in the GCC. ResiliArt is a series of international, virtual conversations seeking to strengthen the resilience of artists and cultural professionals in the face of the pandemic. The Ithra debate theme was Dystopia to Utopia: Our Changing Cultural Landscape and it focused on the shift to digital and the role of government and culture institutions in supporting the arts and culture sectors.

# Finding Beauty in Quarantine Times

In May, Ithra participated in a -24hour global livestream with experts and speakers from around the world called Finding Beauty in Quarantine Times. Organized by the World Economic Forum's Young Global Leader Coalition on Art, Culture and Sport, the livestream gathered 50 representatives from over 20 countries as they hosted back-to-back public online sessions. Ithra's in-house team ran four sessions, covering topics including innovation, art therapy and calligraphy.

As part of the Saudi National Day's celebration, Ithra hosted a night of poetry by Abdulatif bin Yousef and accompanying musicians.



#### Al Farabi

The Saudi National Day's celebration included a musical performance by Al-Farabi Band featuring pianist Abeer Balubaid and singer Amin Farsi. Al Farabi displays musical skill by having each artist perform on various musical instruments. Their lyrics are derived from old Arab poetry and are given a modern twist.



#### **Kingdom of Cultures**

Our Kingdom of Cultures exhibition launched during Saudi National Day. It showcases the natural and cultural beauty and variety of Saudi Arabia through an immersive digital experience that allows the viewer to be surrounded by the culture and landscapes of the Kingdom.

#### **Ithra Art Prize**

Launched in 2017, the Ithra Art Prize supports emerging Saudi and Saudi-based talent in contemporary art.

Partnering with Art Dubai puts the artists before a global audience. The winning work is unveiled at Art Dubai each year, and subsequently joins Ithra's prestigious permanent collection. The winner also receives a grant of up to 100,000\$ to produce the proposal. The selection committee is comprised of highly acclaimed regional and international culture experts.

Ithra Art Prize 2020: Fahad bin Naif was the winner of the third edition of Ithra Art Prize. His installation Rakhm — which means "incubation" in Arabic — aims to conceptually preserve a nursery as both an urban typology and its "incubatees" as an environmental micro-economy.

### 1. Art: Acquisitions

The Ithra Museum is continually acquiring items to showcase to our audiences so they will experience the best of world culture firsthand. Through these acquisitions we are also seeking to establish Ithra and the Kingdom's place at the center of serious high-level scholarship. Our acquisitions are carefully chosen to ensure that they will inform, engage and educate audiences of all ages.



#### **Berber Minbar**

Originally occupying a small Friday mosque in the Atlas Mountains, this 18th century cedar wood minbar was modeled on earlier Berber examples such as the grand Almoravid minbar in the Kutubiyya Mosque in Marrakech (built in 1137). As such, it harkens back to their golden age when Berber tribes ruled large parts of Morocco and Spain.



#### This Place is Mine

This Place is Mine, a photo collage by the Palestinian photographer Hazem Harb. Harb is noted for reflecting his own Palestinian heritage in his work and for examining displacement and diaspora in his art.



#### A Handbook for Hajj Pilgrims

This topographical depiction of the Masjid al Haram (Makkah) is found in a manuscript of the Futuh al-Haramayn (Revelations of the Two Holy Sites) by Muhyi al-Lari (d. 1526). This edition dates from 1703 and was copied by Muhammad Zarif of Rajastan, India. It was used as a guide for pilgrims, illustrating and describing the stations of the Hajj and the rituals.



#### Kiswa Textile

This 19th century silk textile is embroidered with gold and decorated with zigzag patterns and calligraphic inscriptions including the declaration of faith: "There is no god but Allah" and the names "Allah" and "Mohammed" (). It was made in Turkey and either hung on the interior walls of the Ka'ba in Makkah or the Prophet's tomb in Medina.



#### **Astrolabe**

This exquisite cast silver astrolabe is over 700 years old and is signed by Muhammad Ibn Fattuh Al Khumairi, the most renowned astronomer of Islamic Spain. His astrolabes were copied by later astronomers both in the Islamic world and in Europe. Each of the accompanying plates is inscribed with major Spanish cities including Seville, Cordoba and Toledo.



#### GH0809: a Juxtaposition

This artwork, GH0809, by the Palestinian artist Taysir Batnaji, examines the effect of violence against the people of Gaza. The houses are displayed as if they were in a Western real estate agency, but they have all been destroyed. Batnaji himself comes from Gaza, and reflects on the sufferings of the people of his homeland.



#### **Oushak Prayer Rug**

This carpet fragment originally formed part of the central upper tier of a communal multiple niche prayer rug in the Selimiye mosque in Edirne, Turkey. The design of the rug, including its flowers, niche and lamp, would have reflected the splendor of that mosque's interior. It was made in Oushak, Turkey, one of the prime centers for prayer rug design and manufacture, in 1560.

### 2. Creativity

### Tanween 2020: The New Next

Ithra's flagship creativity and innovation festival Tanween successfully concluded its third season in October. The festival was held in a hybrid format delivered with content provided both physically to audiences in the Ithra Theater and online.

The conference featured more than 35 speakers, as well as five three-hour virtual masterclasses with world-class professionals in creative design, data visualization, fashion, and food design. For the first time we offered one-to-one consulting sessions, engaging students and young professionals with experts in their fields.

The theme of Tanween was The New Next – Creativity is the Way Forward. Speakers included chef and entrepreneur Alan Yau, who established Wagamama; Joanna Peña-Bickley from Amazon; Duncan Wardle, formerly of Disney; and Sir Martin Sorrell, regarded by many as the father of modern marketing. In all, the season featured 30 speakers, 16 of them Saudi and a 50-50 balance of men and women.











#### Alsharqiya Gets Creative

Alongside Tanween, Ithra launched Alsharqiya Gets Creative, Ithra's Eastern Province-wide creativity initiative. During the season, Ithra engaged more than 40 businesses, 60 teachers, two universities and 11 schools. Ithra brought together more than 2,500 participants and the videos reached more than 8 million people. The initiative aims to establish the Eastern Province as an artistic destination and cultural hub.

#### Idea Lab Talks

The 2020 Idea Lab Talks allowed our audiences to directly engage with a huge range of creatives and innovators. Among many others, the talks featured: graphic designer Ahmed Alrafai on creative visual communication; architect Khaled Al-Hunaidi, designer of the famous Al-Shaheen units in Asir; Hussain Daghriri on his Makana Hub Project; architect Shahad Azaz on her experience in the market and the importance of transmitting Saudi culture through architecture; Abed Al-Rahman Al-Bader on the importance of creative and original content creation; and Alwaleed Al Keaid on the world of creative economics and business.

### Dialogue in the Dark

At Ithra we believe in inclusion and in heightening empathy among our audiences. Our Great Hall exhibit Dialogue in the Dark gave visitors the experience of being visually impaired as they sought to navigate a market and a busy street while being led by a visually impaired guide. The initiative opened on February 23 and closed on March 14 due to COVID19-. The experience introduced visitors to a world without sight by taking them on a journey in which they had to rely on sounds and textures rather than sight as they navigated experiences in complete darkness. Ithra trained 15 Saudis who are blind or visually impaired to work as guides and show the visitors around the exhibition.





## Working for the Community

Ithra used its -3D production capabilities to produce 2,000 transparent plastic face masks to be used by medical staff and front-line workers. The masks were a contribution to the fight against the COVID19- virus. Volunteers also distributed food aid to people in need.

#### **COVID19- Journal**

We saw the need to give our audiences platforms for creativity, especially given the context of the pandemic. We launched the COVID19- Journal, an online public forum allowing people to share their feelings and personal perspectives. This was a place to share hope as well as frustration. Sometimes it gave the chance to vent, but some found it an opportunity to inspire others. Over 1000 contributions were received

#### Back to School Programs

We did not allow COVID19- to stop our engagement with our younger audiences. We continued to run our Back to School programs in hybrid form to help children, parents and educators adjust to the new "blended" school environment after the long summer holidays.







### Summer and Winter Camps

Despite the pandemic, we continued to run our short learning camps. This year, the summer camp was held online, while the winter camp ran physically. The camps include focused activities to engage and interest children.

#### The Market

As part of our Saudi National Day outreach efforts, we brought our creative vision to the streets of Al-Khobar with a place-making program titled The Market, the opening of which was attended by 12,000 people. The local farmer's market in Al-Ulaya, which had been in need of development, was revamped with upgraded farm-fare kiosks, colorful painting, art installations and added areas for exhibitions, music, performance and public seating, remaking it into an appealing place for the people of Al-Khobar and an attractive new opportunity for local farmers.



#### Y20 Summit

Ithra hosted the Y20 summit in October. The conference, which was held virtually because of the pandemic, brought together young people from across the world to discuss global issues and priorities. The Y20 is the youth-focused element of the G20 summit of world leaders, which was in November in Riyadh.





#### Volunteerism

At Ithra, we offer a pioneering platform for volunteering by offering our volunteers opportunities to exchange information and develop skills, such as the people management and collaboration skills they need to succeed in the modern world. Since the inception of Ithra, the Center has hosted 3,882 volunteers, and there have been 285,001 hours of volunteering.

#### Ithra Talks

As part of the Ithra Connect series we organized exclusive live online talks with international and regional figures. They were the acclaimed English actor Idris Elba, the American astrophysicist Neil deGrasse Tyson, the international architect Kjetil Traedal Thorsen and Ithra's Head of Advisory, Fatmah Al-Rashid.

Elba discussed his acting methodology and how to arrange the logistical elements of the profession, such as looking for roles. Tyson examined subjects as diverse as stimulating curiosity in the classroom and why one should not try to create a mini black hole in a home science lab. Al-Rashid and Thorsen looked at creativity and design, especially in the context of the modern Middle Fast

#### Ithra Academy

Ithra has been hosting a great many workshops, seminars, classes and talks, but this ranging array of offerings will be coalesced in 2021 under the banner of the Ithra Academy. With the increasingly professionalized organization of the Academy, Ithra will be better positioned to partner with leading institutions from the region and around the world – including internationally-recognized certificate programs. Based in Ithra's iconic Ithra Tower, the Academy will continue to focus on creativity, art, prototyping and innovation. Offerings will include hands-on opportunities and skills development in fields as diverse as jewelry-making, fashion design, animation and improv comedy.



### Knowledge Incubator



#### Library

During the COVID19- pandemic, Ithra made library membership free for digital borrowers, thus allowing communities access to e-books and audio books in English and Arabic.



### **5. Culture** Ithraeyat Magazine

Its essence lies in its name, which is based on the plural form of the word "ithra" meaning enrichment. Ithraeyat Magazine is a storehouse of unique, enriching cultural stories from the Kingdom and beyond. It is published in both English and Arabic, but It is unique in featuring specially written Arabic content tailored for the audience, rather than being translated from any other language. Its cover features exclusive debut art creations by groundbreaking Saudi artists, both established and emerging. Digital in format with special printed issues, the magazine partners with the Aga Khan Museum, the Saudi Ministry of Culture, the Art of Heritage Center in Riyadh, Barjeel Art Foundation, Hafez Gallery and Athr Gallery.

#### **iRead**

This was the sixth year of Ithra's National Reading Program, iRead. The closing ceremony for the competition managed by the Ithra Library honored the four Reader of the Year title winners. Since its inauguration, more than 71,000 Saudi youth have participated in the program, which has also hosted more than 100 writers and intellectuals from various countries. The judges bestow seven awards, and in 2020 the audience voted on another electronically. iRead was launched as an Ithra initiative to promote a culture of reading among Saudi youth.



#### Ithra Cultural Days: Vietnam

As a part of Ithra's engagement with different cultures and to fulfill Ithra's mission of promoting world culture and cross-cultural engagement, we launched our new 2020 seasonal program Cultural Days on February 2020, 3. The inaugural festival showcased Vietnam and ran until February 15, highlighting Vietnamese culture through music, performances, food, crafts and other elements.

A particularly popular program was the Vietnamese circus, AO Show, which played to sell-out crowds. The first Cultural Days program was developed in close coordination with the Vietnamese embassy in Riyadh, bringing more than 50 Vietnamese nationals as chefs, performers and crew to Ithra and attracting more than 45,000 visitors.





#### **Eid Parade**

In May, at the height of the lockdown, Ithra organized a new hybrid Eid celebration. This Eid parade featured a livestreamed cavalcade of decorated wagons that went through six cities in the Eastern Province. Through the parade we reached 100,000 people who were locked down when they would normally be visiting friends and family. This was a rare item of live entertainment during one of the toughest times of the COVID19- lockdown.

# An Architectural Masterpiece

### Sense & Sustainability

The year that we opened, we were honored and humbled by the fact that Time magazine named Ithra on its 2018 list of "the 100 greatest places to visit in the world."

Ithra is architecturally unique. A global landmark, the building's steel pipe skin differentiates it from any other building. It combines this newest building technology

with one of the oldest – rammed earth, a combination of uncemented dirt, gravel and clay that is watered and then compressed into a structural form. Rammed earth has excellent insulation, humidity-control and acoustic qualities. Ithra's rammed earth elements proudly feature earth from around the Kingdom, and the use of local materials is a critical sustainability element for LEED certification.

- Ithra's built environment is Gold LEED certified: Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) is the globally recognized US Green Building Council sustainability certification that uses rating systems for every phase of making and using a building the design, construction, operation and maintenance.
- Xeriscaping is an extremely efficient landscaping technique. It is a key feature of Ithra's sustainable design.
   Ithra's campus features local flora in arid beds next to imported species from Australia and Arizona chosen for their ability to thrive in the desert.
- Ithra earned the American Concrete Institute's highest award Excellence in concrete construction in 2019.
- Ithra is conceptualized as a collection of five stones symbolizing unity. The ground level stands for the present, below is the past, and the upper elements represent the future.
- Ithra is wrapped in 93,403 steel tubes totaling more than 360km in combined length. The tubes are just over 75mm in diameter and made of 2mm-thick Duplex 2205, one of the hardest tupes of stainless steel.
- The mashrabiya is a centuries-old cooling system from the region. It is easily recognized throughout the Middle East as the cantilevered wooden screen window system that juts out from traditional buildings, allowing for cool air to enter and warm air to escape. This is how Ithra's steel pipe skin works, it creates a natural air flow that removes solar heat gain. The mashrabiya is celebrated in Ithra's design by the geometrical support screens that surround the covered walkway around the building and the perforated steel gates in the Plaza.
