Day 5 – Thursday

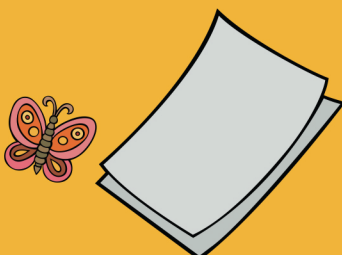
Tempera Colors

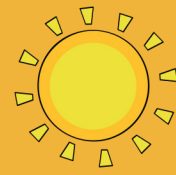
Learn how to create tempera colors, using only kitchen ingredients and create a mountain landscape by finger painting while listening to a podcast.
